Mariateresa Veltri is an adjunct professor of European Union Law and post-doc research fellow at the University of Bologna.

Her research project, entitled "University corridors: from the Italian experience to a European model", aims to identify an innovative link with the EU sponsorship schemes, starting from the analysis and evaluation of the UNI.CO.RE Italian program.

She is also part of the Global Community of Practice on Third Country Education Pathways, and collaborates with diverse international and local NGOs and UN agencies in the field of complementary pathways and community sponsorship.

She graduated cum laude in Law at University of "Roma Tre" (2012), where she obtained her LL.M. degree and her Doctorate in Legal Discipline (2018). Since 2020, she has been teaching assistant in immigration law (University of Pisa), where she has also collaborated with the Dirpolis Institute (Sant'Anna School of Advanced Studies); she is also immigration attorney since 2015 and legal expert for Defence for Children International Italia. Since 2021, she has been coordinator of the Young Research Lab of the Italian "Academy of Law and Migration" (ADiM, University of Tuscia).

Her research interests include immigration and asylum policies, legal migration, community sponsorship, border management, social and cultural rights, citizenship and pathways to inclusion, EU Charter of Fundamental Rights, human rights litigation, children's rights, child friendly justice.
